







































































































## Summer Reading Ideas

Goal: Read 100 books this summer!

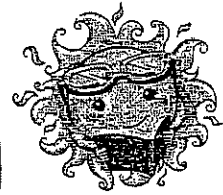
Each  represents 1 book. Every time you read a book, color in one box. When you fill all of the boxes, that means you have read 100 books!

Experts agree that children who read during the summer months gain reading skills while those who do not often slide backwards. Don't let your child experience the "summer slide"!

Choose books from the following list or head to the library and explore the shelves. Children should read for at least 15 minutes each day.

A general rule for selecting books at the appropriate independent reading level is to choose a page and ask your child to read it aloud. If he or she does not know more than 5 words on the page, the book may be too difficult for them to read independently. Don't let that discourage them - consider reading a "too difficult" book aloud to your child. Your child is never too old to enjoy being read to. This opens the door for quality time and interesting conversations.
