Frequently Asked Questions

What are the dates of camp?

Camp runs from May 28th - July 26th. You can register for one week at a time or for the entire summer. We are closed May 27th and July 4th -5th.

The weeks of camp are:

- 1) May 28- 31*
- 2) June 3-7
- 3) June 10-14
- 4) June 17-21
- 5) June 24-28
- 6) July 1-3**
- 7) July 8-12
- 8) July 15-19
- 9) July 22-26

The account payment is due:

* camp will be closed Memorial Day - May 27th

** camp will be closed July 4th and 5th

How much does it cost per week?

- 1 child is \$145 and sibling discounts are available.
- The Camp Leadership Program costs \$55.
- Due to increasingly low demand, we no longer offer a part time option.
- There is a one time \$50 registration fee per child for day campers or a \$5 registration fee for enrichment classes.

Do You Accept Credit Cards?

At the camp desk we accept Visa, Master Card, and Discover. If you register Online we accept Visa and Master Card.

What are the ages of camp?

The camper **must have turned 4 by May 28, 2019** and must be bathroom trained. We enroll campers from ages 4 to 12. We also have a Camp Leadership Program for young adults age 13 to 15.

How do I register?

Our preferred registration is Online registration from our website at www.stns.org. If you are unable to register online, you can print the registration form and send it in, or we can mail you a brochure containing a registration form. Please remember that we close registration for the upcoming week Thursdays at midnight so please register early to avoid delay. Registration reopens for walk-ins each Monday morning at 10:00.

How will the classes be grouped?

The children will be grouped by grade entering, **not by age**. Shifts to a different group can be requested but are not guaranteed.

Grades:

Level 1/ Pre K
Level 2/ Kindergarten
Level 3/ Grade 1
Level 4/ Grade 2
Level 5/ Grade 3
Level 6/ Grade 4
Level 7/Grade 5 and up

What are the Enrichment Classes?

Enrichment classes are offered as additional opportunities for your camper. These classes provide campers a chance to delve more deeply into a topic that interests them. The fees for each enrichment vary; please see the brochure for a detailed list. They are M/Tu/Th/F only. There are no classes on Wednesdays due to field trips. May 27- 31, enrichment classes will be held Tu/W/Th/F . July 1-3 will be held M/Tu/W.

Where is drop off/ pick up? And when?

Children must check in and check out through the camp desk in the cafeteria. Camp opens at 7 am and closes at 6 pm. Homeroom is at 8:30 am, and afternoon camp meeting is at 4:15 pm. There is no additional charge for arriving before homeroom or picking up after camp meeting.

What do I send with my camper?

Please send a sack lunch and any utensils they will need. A morning snack time is available for snacks brought from home. Send sunscreen with your camper. They will also need a towel and swimsuit on their swim days. Also note that we can neither refrigerate nor heat their lunches. Please label everything. We also suggest a change of clothes no matter the camper's age to have on hand if needed.

When are the swim days?

The "L7/ 5th grade and up" group swims four days a week for 1 hour. M/Tu/Th/F.

The "L3/ 1st grade", and "L6/ 4th grade" groups will swim Mondays and Thursdays.

The "L1/pK", "L2/K", "L4/ 2nd grade", and "L5/ 3rd grade" groups will swim Tuesdays and Fridays.

What is the pool like?

The depth of the pool ranges from 3 feet to 5 feet. Everybody takes a swim test before they are allowed to swim. There is a lifeguard and group leader on duty. We use a divider buoy line for the youngest groups.

Where are the field trips this year?

We call our field trip day "Wonderful Wednesday." Our schedule includes: Hamilton Skate, Ruby Falls. The Tennessee Aquarium, The Creative Discovery Museum and Science Theater, and the Challenger Center. Campers will need to wear their camp T-shirt and closed toe shoes on field trip days. There are no field trips the weeks of May 28-31 and July 1-3.
